Annual report 2009

Following its establishment on 1 March 2006, the Sepp Blatter Foundation has now completed its fourth financial year.

The foundation's annual report for 2009 is provided below.

1. Board of Management

The Board of Management has been composed of the following persons since 2006:

- René Imoberdorf, President, Visp
- Sepp Blatter, founder and member, Visp
- Corinne Blatter Andenmatten, member and secretary, Visp
- Jean-Paul Brigger, member, St. Niklaus

2. Activities

Presentation of 2008 award in Ulrichen on 30 August 2009

The 2008 foundation award, worth CHF 10,000, was given to Forum Migration Oberwallis.

The 2008 award was officially presented at the Sepp Blatter Tournament in Ulrichen, Valais on 30 August 2009.

After studying all of the dossiers that were submitted to the foundation, the Board of Management decided to present the award to this organisation, which oversees and coordinates various projects for the integration of asylum-seekers and immigrants. These projects include cultural mentoring for migrants, German courses in various parts of the canton and the promotion of inter-religious dialogue.

Meetings of the Board of Management

The Board of Management held two ordinary meetings in 2009 (18 April and 24 October – both in Visp).

The most important decisions were as follows:

Meeting no. 8, Saturday, 18 April 2009

- Final approval of the financial statement for 2008 and of the balance sheet as at 31 December 2008.

Decision:	- donation fund of:	CHF 100,000.00
	- amount carried over of:	CHF 27,136.45

- Confirmation of 2008 award, worth CHF 10,000, to Forum Migration Oberwallis.
- Analysis of and decision on five applications for financial support, in particular the approval of an application from FC Turtmann for a donation of CHF 1,000 towards tournaments for “E”- and “F”-level youngsters, as well as the presentation of a fair play award and the approval of a donation of CHF 2,500 to FC St-Maurice, also for a youth tournament.
- Approval of the structure and content of the new brochure.

Meeting no. 9, Saturday, 24 October 2009

- Approval of the amendment to art. 1 of the deed of foundation: the name of the foundation has been changed to the Sepp Blatter Foundation (instead of the Sepp Blatter Football and Humanity Foundation).
- Approval of the request for the founder to have sole signatory authority.
- Presentation of the 2009 awards, each worth CHF 10,000, to the Gommer Championship and the Bergdorf Championship.
- Analysis of and decision on three applications for financial support, in particular the approval of an application from Achilles Schnetzer for a donation of CHF 2,500.
- Decision to produce 1,000 caps with the foundation logo.

3. Donations to the foundation

During the reporting year, the foundation again collected funds from the circle of the members of its Board of Management and other donors.

A total of CHF 57,338.00 was donated during the reporting year.

A big thank you to all donors for their support.

4. Revenue and expenses

Expenses of CHF 24,073.68 were incurred during the reporting year. This amount consists of the following:


